



## **COURSE DETAILS:**

### **What to Wear**

All students are required to wear a chef's jacket, long black or khaki pants, and kitchen-safe shoes (closed-toe, non-skid, no lace-ups). Chef's jackets from the school are available for purchase and will be shipped within 2 business days of receiving payment. Please call for more information. An apron and chef hat will be provided and is yours to keep.

### **What will be Provided**

All tools, equipment, and ingredients will be provided. Students will receive a full recipe book and samples to take home.

Continuing Education classes are accredited by the American Culinary Federation for Continuing Education Hours (CEH's). Students will receive a certificate upon completion of the class. The American Culinary Federation Education Foundation accrediting Commission (ACFEFAC) is recognized by the Council for Higher Accreditation (CHEA).

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

Full payment is required at registration to secure your place in the class. Unless paying by cash or credit card, registration will not be confirmed until payment clears. This is applicable for checks, money orders, and other payment methods.

### **Cancellation Policy:**

A full refund (less a \$30 administration fee) will be issued up to 15 days prior to the class start date. No refunds will be issued for cancellations less than 15 days prior to class start. If you choose, you can exchange your refund amount (less the \$30 administration fee) for a credit that can be applied to the cost of another class within one year of cancellation. You must call or email if you choose to receive a credit. The credit cannot be used to purchase merchandise. If the credit does not fully cover the cost of the new class, the student will be responsible for paying the difference.

### **Additional Information:**

The French Pastry School falls under the jurisdiction of City Colleges of Chicago.
