



## ***Continuing Education: Dress Code, Policies, and Terms***

**What to Wear:** All students are required to wear a chef's jacket, long black or khaki pants, and kitchen-safe shoes (closed-toe, non-skid, no laces). FPS Chef jackets are available for purchase from the school and will be shipped within 2 business days of receiving payment. Please call for more information.

**What will be Provided:** All tools, equipment, and ingredients will be provided. Students will receive a full recipe book and samples to take home.

**Age Limits:** Students must be adults to participate in Continuing Education classes. Minors can register for classes if they are at least 16 years old and are accompanied by an adult who is also registered for the class.

**Payment:** Full payment is required at registration to secure your place in the class. If not paying by cash or credit card, registration will not be confirmed until payment clears. This is applicable for checks, money orders, and other payment methods.

**Cancellation Policy:** A full refund (less a \$30 administration fee) will be issued up to 15 days prior to the class start date. If you choose, you can exchange your refund amount (less the \$30 administration fee) for a credit that can be applied to the cost of another class within one year of cancellation. No refunds or credits will be issued for cancellations less than 15 days prior to class start. If the credit does not fully cover the cost of the new class, the student will be responsible for paying the difference. The credit cannot be used to purchase merchandise.

**Continuing Education Hours:** Continuing Education classes are approved by the American Culinary Federation for Continuing Education Hours (CEH's). Students will receive a certificate upon completion of the class. The American Culinary Federation Education Foundation accrediting Commission (ACFEFAC) is recognized by the Council for Higher Accreditation (CHEA).

### **Additional Terms and Conditions:**

- Students will be required to sign a Waiver of Liability and Release when attending the class.
- Video and voice recording is strictly prohibited. Digital or still photos are allowed only during certain times during the class.
